

## Garnet and Gold Scholar Society Intercultural Communication Course Requirement

The following courses are approved to meet the Intercultural course criteria. Students **do not** need to submit these courses for approval.

1. IFS 2052 Global Perspectives: Communication \*Not available in Spring 2016
2. IFS 2070 Thinking Beyond Ourselves: Global Perspectives \*Priority enrollment for Global Citizenship Certificate program
3. INR 3931 Beyond Borders \*Spring only-enrollment for Beyond Borders participants
4. INR 3931 Global Scholars Training Course \*Spring only – enrollment for Global Scholars participants
5. IFS 2098 Global Engagement \*Only available to Fall and Spring students studying abroad with FSU International Programs

### Submitting a Course for Approval

The course must meet the following criteria:

1. 1-3 Credits
2. S/U or letter graded: a C- or S is required

The student must complete the following steps when seeking approval:

1. Submit the course syllabus to [JP-Info@fsu.edu](mailto:JP-Info@fsu.edu)
2. Include in the email/submission answers to the following questions:
  - a. How did the course prompt you to describe at least one culture beyond your own and describe how your worldview isn't universal?
  - b. How did the course prompt you to explain your own cultural identity?
  - c. How did the course prompt you to interpret cultural similarities, differences and your interrelatedness?
  - d. How did the course prompt you to demonstrate effective intercultural communication through collaboration and reflection?

**Note:** Students must have taken a course in the past or are currently enrolled in the course they wish to get approved. Courses students plan to take in the future *will not* be approved. Students MUST receive approval for a course PRIOR to submitting the International area reflection.

### Courses that Meet the Diversity Requirement

Students can search for FSU courses that meet the diversity requirement (cross-cultural diversity [X] or diversity in Western culture [Y]) on the Liberal Studies website: <http://liberalstudiescourses.fsu.edu/care/LS-courses/course-display.php>. **Taking one of these courses *does not* guarantee that it will be approved as an Intercultural Communications course, as courses vary by section, instructor and semester.** Students must submit these courses for approval.
